



This document describes the approved school uniform policy starting school year 2015-16.

Uniform Policy

UNIFORM & PERSONAL GROOMING

Pilgrim believes that good grooming and neat appearance are essential parts of the total person and aid the individual as he or she witnesses the Gospel to the community at large and to those within the school itself. Keeping this in mind, it is our goal at Pilgrim for the students to appear neat, clean, well groomed, and tastefully dressed. We expect parents to help monitor the appearance of their children.

Toddler through Pre-Kindergarten

These students are to wear comfortable clothing which allows them to play both inside and out without “fear” of getting messy. Sneakers provide the best traction for the busy activities and play that they enjoy. It is necessary to keep a change of clothes at school. Uniforms are not required. (Pre-K students may need to have separate athletic shoes for gym use only.)

Kindergarten through Eighth Grade

All students are required to wear uniforms purchased from Parker School Uniform or through Pilgrim Lutheran School resale. Parker School Uniforms’ nearest store is located at 3817 Bellaire Blvd., between Stella Link and Braes Blvd. Parker School Uniforms keeps a copy of our uniform list and all required components. Uniforms are also available online at www.parkersu.com. The ID number is **HO071328**. It may be wise to begin the year with a minimal number of items as your child may grow during the year and require a change of clothing size.

** (Parker) indicates item must be purchased through Parker School Uniforms and not from outside stores.*

Girls' Casual Uniform

Long sleeved undershirts are permitted under the short sleeve polo shirt in black or white only. Modesty shorts must be worn under all skirts and jumpers.

Girls' Dress Uniform

Long sleeved undershirts are not permitted under the short-sleeve blouse. Modesty shorts must be worn under all skirts and jumpers.

Boys' Casual Uniform

Undershirts are permitted under the short sleeve polo shirt in black or white only.

Undershirts are not permitted under the short sleeved Oxford shirt.

General Uniform Comportment

Only properly sized garments are permitted. All shirts, with the exception of the sweatshirt, sweater and the girls' three quarter sleeve blouse, must be tucked in and properly buttoned.

A black or brown dress belt is to be worn with all belt looped garments. Pants need to be belted at the waist (no sagging). Shorts, skirts, skorts, and jumpers must extend beyond the student's fingertips when standing and may not be worn higher than 3 inches above the knee. Issues with length will be handled on a one-on-one basis.

Outerwear

In the classroom students may wear plain (no words or graphics) sweaters, sweatshirts, and jackets in white, navy blue, black, as well as the approved Parker outerwear. On cold days, any appropriate heavy coats are allowed outside the building. Only navy blue outerwear will be permitted in the classroom with the Dress Uniform.

Shoes and Socks

Any appropriate athletic or dress shoes (no wheels or lights) may be worn by students. Socks should match the hemline of the pants/shorts. Boots are not to be worn on campus, unless allowed for special dress days as determined by the Principal/teacher. Colors of shoes and shoelaces are to be primarily brown, black, navy blue, white, grey, or neutral. Dress shoes are encouraged on chapel days. Sling sandals and "flip-flops" are not permitted. (A rule of thumb: all shoes should have a closed toe and a back.)

Jewelry

Appropriate, modest jewelry may be worn as part of school dress. Girls may only wear one pair of stud earrings or one pair of small hoops no larger than a dime. In addition, medically necessary jewelry may be worn.

Hair

Hair must be properly groomed. Extremes in haircuts or styles will not be permitted. Only a natural hair color is acceptable. Boys need to have hair cut above the collar and the ear. Girls' hair bows are allowed in white, red, navy blue, or Pilgrim plaid.

Make-Up

Girls in any grade may wear clear nail polish. Nail polish with color is not allowed. Only girls in 7th-8th grade may wear makeup in moderation. Make-up with glitter is not allowed.

Gym Uniform

All students in PS-8th grade are required to have separate athletic shoes for gym use only. Children in preschool through fourth grade do not wear a separate gym uniform, but children in 5th-8th grade are required to wear the Pilgrim gym uniform, which must be purchased in the school store. Students in grades five through eight who do not “dress-out” for Physical Education (PE) will be issued a uniform non-compliance. Three non-compliances will result in a detention. Students are to change back to their school uniform prior to returning to class.

School Spirit Friday

Every Friday is “Pilgrim Spirit Day”. This means all students may wear any Pilgrim Spirit shirt or any yearly theme shirt in place of the casual uniform shirt. Uniform bottoms must be worn.

AR Shirt Day

Every Monday, any students who have earned an Accelerated Reading (AR) T-shirt may wear it in place of the casual uniform shirt. Uniform bottoms must be worn.

Yearbook Shirt

Yearbook shirts may be worn on days of yearbook meeting dates, except if that occurs on a chapel day.

School Picture Days

Students must wear uniforms for the fall individual pictures and the group class pictures. They may wear appropriate free dress attire for the spring individual pictures. (See Free Dress Days)

Free Dress Days

Students may wear clothes of their choice as long as they are neat, school appropriate, non-distracting, and with no offensive or inappropriate pictures or graphics. Students are to dress in a clean, neat, and comfortable manner. Modest shorts and skirts (three inches or less above the knee) and modest tops are to be worn. Tops may not have print, pictures, etc. that contradict Christian values and morals (i.e. alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, concert shirts, inappropriate wording, etc.). Students are to properly wear totally enclosed shoes with socks. Belts are to be worn appropriately with clothing that is designed for belts (no sagging). Make-up is to be modest. Students are not to wear backless attire, halter-type or midriff tops, spaghetti strapped tops, tank tops, cut-off shirts, low cut tops, sheer material clothing, miniskirts, or hip hugger/low rise slacks or jeans with cuts, holes, or tears. Questionable dress will be addressed by the teacher and Principal.

Boy Scout, Girl Scout, and other Uniforms

The official dress uniform of the Boy and Girl Scouts of America may be worn on the designated meeting day of their organization. The Pilgrim uniform shorts, pants, skirts, or skorts may be

substituted for the lower garment. Jeans are not allowed. Cheerleaders may wear their official Pilgrim cheerleading uniform on days designated by their sponsors.

Dress Code Violations

In grades K-4th, dress code violations will be handled by the homeroom teacher. In grades 5th-8th, dress code violations will be handled by the homeroom teacher and/or the Principal. For infractions of the dress code, students will receive a warning. For repeated infractions, students will receive a Uniform Non-Compliance form, which must be signed by the parent and returned. After the first and any additional Uniform Non-compliance issuance(s) for the same offense, a student in grades K-4th will lose a recess. After the first Uniform Non-compliance issuance in grades 5th-8th, a student will serve a detention.
