We have a lot of fun activities planned for our campers this summer!

Each week will follow a different theme, so we will always have something new and fun to do!

Themes:

Week 6 (July 11 - July 15) "The Sound of Music" - Music comes in many forms. This week campers will explore the many ways to make music, and even test their singing and performing skills with "Karaoke 4 Kids"!

Week 7 (July 18 - July 22) "Seuss-A-Palooza" - Dr. Seuss is loose at Pilgrim! Campers will have fun with the many works of Dr. Seuss and all of his wild characters. Oh, the Places You'll Go!

Week 8 (July 25 - July 29) VBS - "Big Apple Adventure" - Grab a cab and get ready for fun around every corner in LifeWay's Big Apple Adventure™: Where Faith and Life Connect. As kids explore the big city, they'll learn how to step out in faith and connect with Jesus - sharing the message of Christ with their world.

Week 9 (Aug 1 - Aug 5) "Under the Big Top" - Fun and adventure are waiting as campers explore the many wonders of the circus!

Week 10 (Aug. 2 - Aug. 6) "Sampling the Senses" - Activities this week will revolve around the 5 senses... Sight, Sound, Smell, Taste and Touch.

These will be staff work days to prepare for the first day of school, Wednesday, August 17th.

Final Registration for students attending Pilgrim in the 2011/2012 school year will be Tuesday, August 9th from 3pm - 7pm. All parents of students, Toddler - 8th grade, are required to attend anytime between 3pm & 7pm. This is where you turn in paperwork (a packet of forms will be given to you prior to this date), sign up for after school activities, purchase / pick up supplies, and take care of any loose ends before school starts. We ask that you make every effort to attend final registration. Processing paperwork for every student takes time and we will only have a week to do this before school starts. If you absolutely cannot attend, please make arrangements with the school office to complete your registration prior to the first day of school, preferably no later than Friday, August 12th.

Tuesdays - Every Tuesday Kid Fit USA will come to Pilgrim and have fun classes with sport-related activities (set to music) geared toward young children. It's a lot of fun and the children really enjoy it! Then, each class will also do activities in their individual classes related to the weekly theme.

Wednesdays - Every Wednesday our campers will go to "Son"shine Shop, our summer version of Chapel. Campers will also have cooking projects related to the weekly theme. Some are edible, some are not! If any actual cooking (using a stove or oven) is done, that part of the project will be handled only by our teachers. Safety first!

Thursdays - Every Thursday the Tumble Tyke bus comes! This is a hollowed out, air-conditioned bus with gymnastics equipment inside. Plenty of padding too! Tumble Tykes has been coming to Pilgrim for many years and they are wonderful!! Each class will also do activities in their individual classes related to the weekly theme.

Fridays - The most popular day of the week! Every Friday is Splash Day (weather permitting). We will have water related activities including a water slide for PS - 2nd grade. If you are not comfortable with your child using the water slide, please inform the school office and teachers ahead of time. The water activities will be well supervised. Toddlers will have baby pools (with very little water) and other fun water toys. They will get wet! We ask that you send your child to camp in their bathing suits and apply sunscreen prior to arrival. If you would like to send additional sunscreen, please label it with your child's name and give it to the teacher. Children are welcome to and also encouraged to wear water shoes. Make sure to send a towel (labeled with the child's name) and a dry change of clothes; shirt, bottoms and include underwear, socks and shoes. Please send a plastic bag for wet clothes and towels to come home in. Splash day will be on if light rain is falling as long as there is no thunder & lightening.

We conclude every Friday with a movie on the big screen in the Parish Hall at 3pm for PS - 2nd grade, including movie snacks! Toddlers will have a separate movie with snacks in a separate room with a movie appropriate for their age and attention spans. Ordering

The teachers will take the orders and the coupons in the classrooms on the day you wish to order.

All orders must be placed by 9:00 a.m.

No orders will be taken after this time or by phone.

If a lunch is not ordered for your child, you must provide a cold lunch. We do not order extra lunches.

Cost

The cost for each lunch is \$3.50 You will need to purchase "lunch coupons" in the office with CASH ONLY! Please do not leave any money with the teachers. The teachers are not responsible for keeping track of the children's lunch money.

Money from the child's cafeteria hot lunch account can not be used for this purpose.

There will be no refunds for lost or unused coupons.

The coupons will be available in the school office beginning Monday, May 23rd.

Important Information

Snacks

You will need to provide a morning & afternoon snack. Please send a small nutritious snack and a drink with your child each day.

Bags

It will be helpful if your child brings a bag to school each day. This will make it easier for them to keep up with their things and get camp projects home.

Medication

All medicine will be dispensed from the office. You will need to bring all medicine in the original container to the office and sign a medication authorization form.

Lunch

A hot lunch may be purchased each day for \$3.50 (includes a drink), **CASH ONLY**. Lunch must be ordered by 9:00 a.m. to allow the restaurants adequate time to prepare large orders. If hot lunch is not ordered, you must provide your child with a cold lunch. The cafeteria is closed during the summer so we are unable to feed children who don't bring or order a lunch. We are unable to heat lunches or store cold lunches. Please pack lunches with a frozen cold pack to keep cold lunches cold, and pack hot items in a thermos to keep warm.

Naps

Children in Toddler, PS, & PK classes will rest every afternoon. We have nap mats available for purchase for \$26. If you do not purchase a nap mat, please provide a blanket and pillow for your child to lay on. Nap things will be sent home every Friday for you to wash and return.

TIMES

Our hours are from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. All special programs will be done in the morning before lunch. Afternoon activities will be conducted by the teachers of each individual classroom. Please remember that if your child is not picked up by six, you will be charged a late fee.
